The Museum of Karelian Poets and Writers was founded on April 11, 2022 at school 38 in Petrozavodsk. It presents more than 60 exhibits. The main exhibition is dedicated to Andrey Sungurov, Viktor Sergin and Anatoly Gordienko, who lived and wrote their works in the

RepublicofKarelia.Amongtheexhibitstherearehandwrittenbooks,certificates,diplomas,letters,photographsfromfamilyarchivesprovidedbytheirrelatives.



The museum collection of Gordienko's personal belongings has his favorite book "The Gadfly" in the Ukrainian language, a guitar and a typewriter. His gloves, a tie and a beret have been preserved too.



The most memorable thing of Andrey Sungurov is a fairy tale book for children written in Braille.



A handwritten book made of birch bark, made by Viktor Sergin himself, has also been preserved.

On the wall there is a portrait gallery dedicated to the deceased writers. Among them are: Marat Tarasov, Dmitry Gusarov, Alexander Volkov, Igor Vostryakov, Armas Mishin, Pavel Kostin, Yuri Linnik, Antti Timonen, Ortier Stepanov, Viktor Potievsky.





There is also an exhibition of books by modern Karelian poets and writers. For example, by Elena Pietilainen, Nadezhda Vasilyeva and others. On the basis of the museum there is a School of a Young Guide. The Museum hosts meet-the-writer events, as well as educational projects and literature lessons.



In the library, there is a memorial plaque to Andrei Sungurov, who went to our school.


