

i-NESIS main features

- 1. Registered non-profit association and based in the EU.
- 2. Includes a number of Syrian experts in the diaspora and homeland, which is constantly expanding.
- 3. Gathers multiple practices from different vital fields.
- 4. The association is independent in its activity from the influence or work of government, internal or external political organizations.
- 5. The objectives and activities of the association are based on the priorities and needs of the general interest of the Syrian society (social, cultural and economic development).











Our Goals

Syrian civil society has potential to establish and develop its own sustainable development process and to reconstruct the country. i-NESIS goals lie in:

- Rehabilitation of Man and Society at the level at which it competes with other human societies
- Promoting innovative development and directed creativity in Syria through specialized and diverse vital projects that move society from a consuming to a productive culture.

- Specialized website to gather and collaborative study of problems, tasks, ideas and






